

Quran Sciences Program – Curriculum Details

RCM's Quran Sciences Program is specifically designed for elementary and middle school students looking for a stronger focus in Qur'an and Classical Arabic. QSP classes are organized by the student's Arabic reading and writing competency and not by grade.

The QSP curriculum is structured around two main categories:

Quran: Students are divided into the two learning levels listed below.

Level 1 - Nouraniya: Students learn how to read Arabic as it is written in the Quran using the Nouraniya methodology. On average, students who start with no knowledge of Arabic are able to read from the Quran alone after two years, given that they have enrolled in the weekday schedule and attend class twice a week. A portion of the beginner class is dedicated to writing Arabic and building Arabic vocabulary.

Supplies: Nouraniya Book. Parents must download App so that their child(ren) may practice at home.

Level 2- Tilawa: Students will have the opportunity to practice reading in class with the help of experienced teachers. They will be coached on their Quran reading skills by regularly analyzing and practicing the Tajweed rules. Please keep in mind that students in Tilawa may be divided into different levels.

Supplies: Copy of Juz 29 or 30.

Arabic: Students are divided into the three levels listed below.

1-Letters: In this level, students learn how to write individual letters as well as words from the Quran.
Supplies: QSP Book (provided)

2-Stories: In this level, students are exposed to sentences through short stories, custom written using words from the Quran. Each sentence comes with an illustration and a space to practice writing.
Supplies: QSP Book (provided)

3-Duaa: In this level, students learn the meaning of dua's from the Quran. They practice writing and memorizing the dua's.
Supplies: QSP Book (provided)
